Vocabulary = The whole SET of WORDS present in a LANGUAGE; TERM(S) = Word(s) in a specific field

Grandfather + Grandmother;

Father + Mother    Aunt(s) + Uncle(s) ( Both sides ) → Cousin(s) [ Child(ren) of Aunt, Uncle ];

Husband + Wife ( both could have Brother(s), Sister(s) ); Daughter-In-Law, Son-In-Law;

Father-In-Law + Mother-In-Law;

Brother-In-Law + Mother-In-Law;

Daughter(s), Son(s);

Granddaughter(s), Grandson(s);

### **Additional FAMILY VOCABULARY:**

Adult(s), Baby(Babies), Boy(s), Child(ren), Couple(s), Gender(= one's SEX, masculine, feminine, neuter), Generation(s), Girl(s), Grandchild(ren), Grandparent(s), Madam or Mesdames(Mrs. = singular and plural), Man(Men), Mister(Mr. = singular, Messrs = plural), Miss(Ms = singular, an unmarried woman), Parent(s), Partner(s), Relative(s), Stepdaughter(s), Teenager(s), Twin(s), Stepfather(s), Stepmother(s), Stepson(s), Triplet(s), Woman(Women), Youngster(s)
