

FOOD - FRUITS - VEGETABLES - TOOLS

KITCHEN TOOLS or **UTENSILS** are being used to cook and prepare meals made from food, fruits and vegetables such as bowls, corkscrew, cutlery, fish slice, funnel, grater, ladle, lid, saucepans, sieves, etc.
