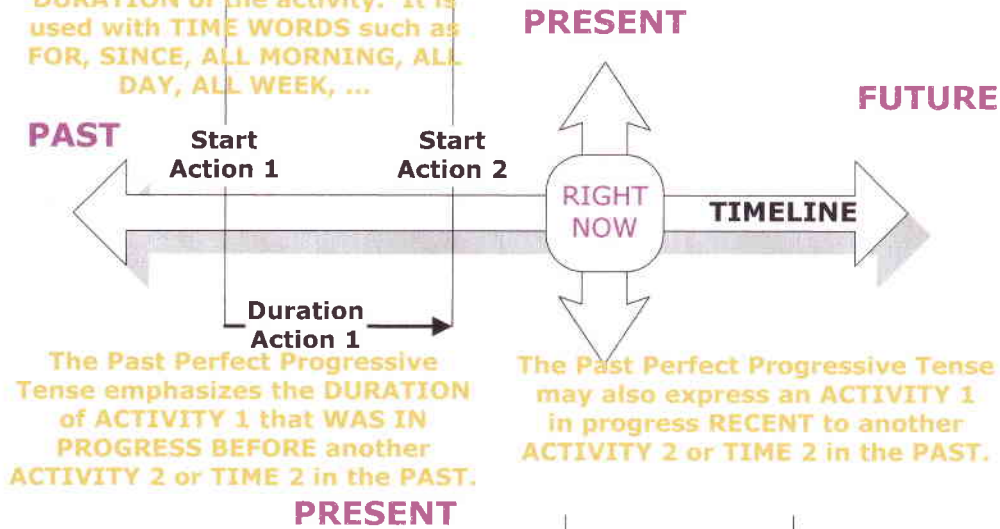


PRESENT PERFECT PROGRESSIVE TENSE

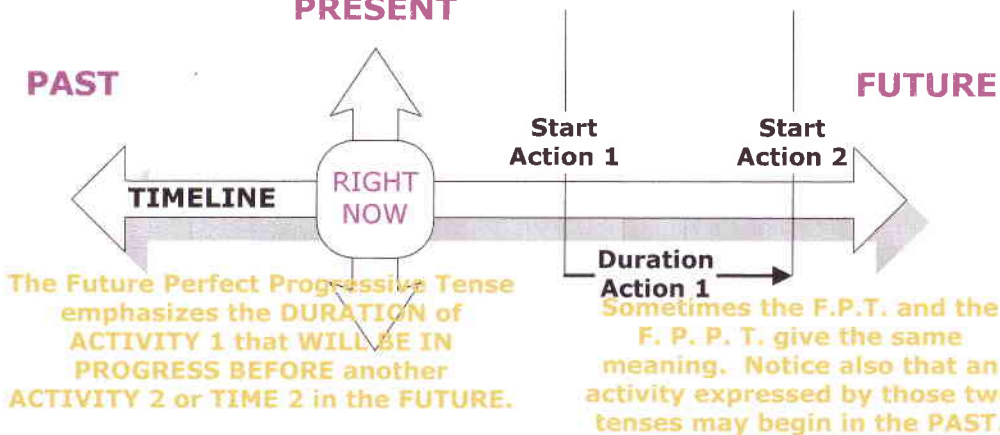
Planet Earth **HAS BEEN GOING** around the Sun for ages.

PAST PERFECT PROGRESSIVE TENSE

Planet Earth **HAD BEEN GOING** around the Sun for ages when a large asteroid [as|ter|oid] hit it.

[AS|TER|OID] = PIECES OF MATTER that move around the SUN between the planets Mars and Jupiter



FUTURE PERFECT PROGRESSIVE TENSE

Planet Earth **WILL HAVE BEEN GOING** around the Sun for ages when a significant cosmic event destroys our planetary home.

RULES: "FORMS of TO HAVE + BEEN + (VERB 2 + -ING = Present Participle)" for PRESENT and PAST PERFECT PROGRESSIVE TENSES; and "WILL + HAVE + BEEN + (VERB 2 + -ING = Present Participle)" for FUTURE PERFECT PROGRESSIVE TENSE.
